## Leadership Spotlight

### Eric J. Frisch



This week's spotlight is on **Eric J. Frisch**, a partner in the Atlanta office of **Carlock, Copeland and Stair, LLP**, and the webpage chair for DRI's Trial Tactics Committee. He also served as the Young Lawyer Liaison to the Trial Tactics Committee and has been a regular contributor to DRI publications.

Mr. Frisch concentrates his practice on complex medical malpractice, health care, legal malpractice, and commercial cases. In addition, he has contributed to several appellate decisions on medical malpractice, commercial and constitutional issues in the federal and state courts, including as *amicus curiae*.
